Restauro 2012-GENERAL REGULATIONS OF THE FAIR
INTEGRATED TECHNICAL EXHIBITION REGULATIONS (available at www.salonedelrestauro.com)

Art. 1 – ORGANISATION

In this agreement, "Fair" shall mean Ferrara Fiere Congressi S.r.l. - The Restauro trademark is the property of BolognaFiere S.p.A.. - In this agreement, ACROPOLI srl., hereinafter referred to as the "Secretariat", is the Organising Secretariat of Restauro, which will take place in the Fair District of Ferrara from March 28th to March 31st 2012, open from 9.30 am to 6.30 pm. Admission tickets: 10 euros, concessions 5 euros.

Art. 2 - ADMISSION

The Organising Secretariat guarantees equal opportunities for all operators; in particular, the following operators will be admitted: a) Italian or foreign companies exhibiting their own products or services, provided such products or services fall within the type of commodities for which the Fair has been intended. If the manufacturing companies are unable to take part in the Fair, they can be represented by their dealers, delegates, or general and exclusive agents. b) trade associations, public bodies and organisations that are officially engaged in promotion, study, information and dissemination in the fields that may be of interest for the Fair. The Secretariat reserves the right to admit to the Fair companies, bodies and organisations that are not covered by the articles above or to ban the exhibition of specific services, products or samples, or forbid the exhibition of products, samples or services of the same company in multiple pitches in the same class of commodities.

Art. 3 - PARTICIPATION IN THE FAIR — The submission of the application for participation in the fair, drawn up in a special form, constitutes a binding proposal for the applicant and involves the acceptance of these "General Terms and Conditions", as well as the "Technical Exhibition Regulations" and any other rule concerning the organisation and conduction of the Fair and the Fair District. Dealers, delegates, or general and exclusive agents shall enclose, with their applications, a list of the companies they represent and whose products they intend to exhibit. Applicants shall provide any other document that may be required to decide whether to accept such application and to check – at any time – if the terms and conditions for participation in the Fair are adhered to. If the application for participation is accepted, the applicant is notified of such decision by an approved courier, thus officially becoming an exhibitor. If the application for participation is rejected, the applicant is notified of such decision, stating the reasons for such rejection.

Art. 3 bis – LIMITED LIABILITY — The Organising Secretariat will not be held liable for any damage to third parties resulting from the exhibition of any service, product or sample, without prejudice to the provisions laid down by articles 2 and 3 of the general terms and conditions for participation in the Fair. Any controversy relating to the content of an exhibited service, product or sample shall be filed against the exhibitors, who hereby undertake to indemnify the Organising Secretariat from any liability for the exhibition of any such service, product or sample in the booths of the Fair, including any appurtenance, and in any publication on the exhibition in Italy and abroad.

Art. 4 – PAYMENT — Applicants who have received from the Secretariat a written confirmation of acceptance of the application and the prepayment invoice must settle their payment by 9th March 2012. Any invoice received by the applicant after such date shall be settled on sight. To take possession of the allocated exhibition area, the participants must show a receipt of their payment to the Organising Secretariat, at the Fair District of Ferrara. Not other form of payment shall be accepted.

Art. 5 – ALLOCATION OF BOOTHS — Booths shall be allocated by the Secretariat, at its sole discretion. Any suggestion or special requirement put forward by the Exhibitor shall be for information only, and will not be binding or conditional on the application for participation, and as such they will not be regarded as given. In addition, the Secretariat may move, reduce the allocated booth or relocate it to a different exhibition area, and in this case the participant will not be entitled to any damage or compensation whatsoever. However, the Secretariat shall inform the Exhibitor by registered letter (or by fax or telegram).

Art. 6 – WAIVER – TERMINATION – DEFAULT — A participant who may not take part in the Fair because of some unexpected, legitimate and grounded inability can terminate the agreement, providing evidence of such inability and informing the Secretariat by registered letter with advice of receipt at least 90 days before the opening day of the Fair; in this case, the Secretariat will hold on to the registration fee and 50% of the participation fee, subject to any further refund for major damage. If instead such notice is served less than 90 days from the opening date of the Fair, the participant shall pay the full participation fee in addition to the registration fee, subject to any further refund for major direct and consequential damage. However, in this case, the Secretariat will be free to use the booth, which may be allocated to other Exhibitors. The reasons for the company's inability to participate in the Fair will be judged by the Secretariat. Should the Exhibitor fail to fit out its own booth by the deadline stated in the "Technical Exhibition Regulations", the Exhibitor will be considered in default, to all intents and purposes, and as well as paying the registration fee and the full participation fee, the Exhibitor shall refund any direct and consequential damage incurred by the Secretariat. In this case, the Secretariat will be free to use the booth, which may be allocated to other Exhibitors. The Secretariat may decide to terminate the participation agreement up to two weeks before the opening date of the Fair, and – for reasons related to the organisation or regular operation of the fair – up to the opening day. In this case, the Secretariat will not be bound to pay any damage or compensation whatsoever but shall refund the registration fee and the participation fee if already paid by the participant.

Art. 7 – DELIVERY OF BOOTHS — Booths will be allocated to the Exhibitors as follows: 26th-27th March 2012 from 8 am to 6 pm, according to the terms and conditions stated in the "Technical Exhibition Regulations". Booths are to be fitted out before 6 pm on March 27th; failing this, the agreement may be

terminated due to the participant's breach, in the same ways and with the same consequences as for art. 6.

Art. 8 - FITTINGS— Prefitted structures are described in the "Technical Exhibition Regulations" and its annexes relating to the preparation.

Fittings shall be laid out within the surface of the booth, as detailed in the "Technical Exhibition Regulations". It is forbidden to hang posters, graphics or otherwise alter the outside of the booth or the fitting frames. Graphics with the corporate name will be developed by the Secretariat; it shall be the same for all exhibitors with fitting booths. Fittings and plants shall be professionally built, in accordance with the applicable accident-prevention and fire-prevention regulations.

The Secretary has the power to examine and modify the designs of which stands in importance, size and resulting dangers outside the standard of productions traditional and The exhibitor has the obligation to provide the technical drawings and the names of the technicians responsible for structural part and the part outfits, and the systems; same obligation exists for the stands, buildings, pavilions and exhibitions in the outdoor areas.

Will FerraraFiere may require action by the Supervisory Committee for places of public entertainment. We emphasize that the establishment of a second floor should have received the approval of the project by the Organizing Secretariat, may not exceed 60% of stand area allocated. That area will be counted as a "privileged" to which the maximum tariff will be applied on the pavilion or area assigned. The Exhibitor acknowledges that the Expo Center and similar to places of public entertainment and undertakes to respect the relevant regulations and to submit to all the provisions and procedures laid down by the "Technical Exhibition Regulations." Failure to deliver to FerraraFiere the declarations and documentation provided in the "Technical Exhibition Regulations" for accountability in the field of exhibition and electrical FerraraFiere attach to the possibility of closing the stand and to take all necessary measures to ensure safe, without prejudice to any civil or criminal liability of the Exhibitor. FerraraFiere reserves the right to amend or renew the fittings and installations not covered in the forecast above. All liability for the statics of the stands, in the implementation and operation of the plant and the possible damages that might be subject persons or property owned by FerraraFiere or third parties, shall be borne solely by the Exhibitor. FerraraFiere may formulate, with the aim of the legislation on occupational safety, specific criteria for access to the fairgrounds during the work of construction, as well as limit the access of media and / or provide objections if the means of staying out of space and / or schedules. Any breach of these rules and those contained in the Rules of Participation entitles FerraraFiere to take precautionary measures against fire position of the firm with irregular, which may include, in the case of supplementary measures were taken of the general safety conditions, the charge of the corresponding costs are estimated at not less than Euro 300,00 / exhibition module or an order to dismantle all or part of the stand and the declaration of non-practicability of the stand. Any breach of safety rules may lead to prosecution.

Art. 9 – RETURN OF THE BOOTHS — The Exhibitors may not remove their products and materials until the end of the Fair and no earlier than 6.30 pm on Saturday March 31st, then they can continue wrapping up on April 1st – 2nd from 8 am to 6 pm, and, after taking an exit permit from the Secretariat, they can remove their products and materials from the Fair District. It is strictly forbidden to start wrapping up the boots while the Fair is open. Even if the exit permits are only given to those Exhibitors who have settled all their direct or indirect payments with the Secretariat, such exit permits will not constitute a receipt of payment for participation in the Fair and will only apply to the vehicle associated with such permit. The booths must be vacated before 6 pm on April 2nd. The participant authorises the Secretariat to check if the vehicles and baggage of the Exhibitor and/or the Exhibitor's delegates leaving the Fair District contain any product or material other than those installed in the booth and covered by the exit permit. The participant authorises the Secretariat to prevent any product or material not covered by the exit permit leaving the premises. The Secretariat will not be responsible for any goods, materials or anything that is left unattended by the Exhibitors within the Fair District. If the booth is not vacated before the above deadline, the booth will be cleared by the Secretariat and anything left in the booth will be considered waste material, which shall be disposed of in a public dumping ground, and the Exhibitor shall refund any direct or consequential cost incurred for such clearance, plus a € 260,00 fine, subject to any other major damage.

Art. 10 – ACCESS TO THE FAIR DISTRICT — Access to the Fair District during the fair will be given to professional operators and visitors having an admission document, every day, during the opening hours, which the Secretariat will decide and may change, even during the Fair. To let the Exhibitors and their staff enter the Fair freely, the Secretariat will provide them with special cards, the amounts of which will be proportional to the size of each exhibition area: 3 Exhibitor cards up to 16 square metres, 5 Exhibitor cards up to 48 square metres, 7 Exhibitor cards up to 64 square metres and beyond, 2 Car parking cards to park within the Fair District. However, the Exhibitor shall be fully responsible for the conduct of all the people to whom the Exhibitor gives the admission cards, as well as for the conduct of the Exhibitor's staff, assistants and collaborators in the performance of their jobs. Within the Fair District, it is absolutely forbidden to promote any fund raising for recognised institutions, collections, political, religious or biased propaganda, or otherwise engage in any activity unless relevant to the purposes of the Fair.

Art. 11 - SECURITY — During the opening hours, the Exhibitors shall watch over their own booths either directly or through their own staff. Although it provides a general day and night security service within the Fair District, all through the fair and during the time allocated for the fitting out and wrapping up of the booths, the Secretariat will not be held liable for any theft and/or damage.

Art. 12 -INSURANCE —FerraraFiere will put the agreement ensures that the Exhibitor in good standing with the "application process" (Art. 3) and with payments due under contracts of insurance to cover the following risks:

- All Risks cover for material damage and direct to furnishings, furniture, equipment and goods in the stand, not money, values, and the like precious: € 10,000.00 in first loss (including fire and theft) with an absolute excess of € 100 00 for all the damage. The insurance provided is meant by the time the insured goods are removed from the place where they are to be brought into the rooms and areas located within the enclosure of the Expo Center Ferrara and continues without interruption during the long storage period. The warranty is also valid during the removal from the place where it has remained dormant and during the journey back to the place of origin, however made, provided that the goods appear properly packaged. Transportation of goods can be secured by whatever means of locomotion. If the Exhibitor for a more precise protection, consider it to secure it with higher ceilings may be sure is effected by the Company of its trust or through the form n° 10 "Integrative Insurance Policy."
- Warranty liability: combined single limit of € 10,000,000.00 for the RCT and € 3,000,000.00 to € 2,000,000.00, with a limit per person for the RCO, valid from the beginning of the phase of preparing at the end of phase dismantling exclusively within the Fairgrounds. Exhibitors are civilly and criminally liable for all damages to persons or property caused by the equipment, facilities or anything else in this provision, as well as done or its agents and / or agents.

Art. 13 - INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY — The exhibited goods and products as well as the booths in which they are exhibited may not be photographed, drawn or otherwise reproduced without the authorisation of the Exhibitors and the Secretariat. However, the Secretariat reserves the right to film, reproduce, disseminate and authorise the filming, reproduction and dissemination of any internal or external, general or detailed view, and may sell them or authorise others to sell them.

Art. 14 - TEMPORARY EXPORT — The temporary export of foreign goods or products to be exhibited at the Fair shall take place – at the Exhibitor's expense – through the official forwarding agent of the Fair, as described in the " Technical Exhibition Regulations ", but the Fair will not be responsible for the conduct of the forwarding agent.

Art. 15 - PRESENTATION OF PREFABRICATED CONSTRUCTIONS, SCAFFOLDS ETC AND REGULATIONS ON RUNNING MACHINERY ON DISPLAY —For the display of prefabricated structures, tower cranes, crane cranes and the like of scaffolding, frameworks and staging in general, exhibitors will also secure the full and faithful implementation of all safety standards, legislative, regulatory and good technique, and lessons drawn from experience and prudence during the entire period of stay in the fairground is committed to fully respect as specified in the Technical Exhibition Regulations that will be sent as an attachment to ' allocation of exhibition space.

Art. 16 - UTILITIES - TECHNICAL SERVICES — At the Exhibitors' request and according to the provisions laid down by the "Technical Exhibition Regulations", the Fair will provide the Exhibitors with electricity for lighting and motive power, and a connection to the water mains. In addition, the Fair may set up or contract out or license out any service it deems useful for the participants and shall decide how to operate them. In particular:

— Connections between the electric grid or the water system built by the Exhibitors, and the pull box and the water intakes, respectively, may only be built by companies approved by the Fair, that will make sure such plants comply with the " Technical Exhibition Regulations ".

— The booths shall be cleaned by the Exhibitors, at the Exhibitors' expense, through their own staff or using the cleaning contractor approved by the Fair.

— Telephone connections may only be made by the contractor approved by the Fair.

— For any portage, transport, loading and unloading of goods, unless they use their own vehicles or staff, the Exhibitors shall only use the Official Forwarding Agent of the Fair.

The Exhibitor agrees that the "services/utilities" (either directly managed by the Fair or contracted out or licensed out) will perform to normal standards, provided they will use such services according to normal standards, and in any case the Exhibitor relieves the Fair, as well as any service contractor or agent, from any liability for any service failure.

Art. 17 - PRINTED AND ONLINE INFORMATION

The Secretariat will draw up a Catalogue and will disseminate the information (even in a shortened or abbreviated form) contained in the Application for Participation on the Exhibitors and their products and/or services as well as on anything that is exhibited or presented, using the communication media or techniques (printouts, CD ROMs, web or other) it will deem most suitable and shall not be held responsible for any omission, mistake or failure. Such details will be taken from the applications for participation that have been received and accepted up to 45 days before the opening date of the Fair, without prejudice to the Secretariat's right to change the allocation of the booths.

Art. 18 - PAID ADVERTISEMENTS — Outside the allocated exhibition area, any form of propaganda or advertisement shall only be made through the Secretariat or the Fair's agents and will be subject to payment of a fee plus taxes.

Art. 19 - PARKING WITHIN THE FAIR DISTRICT — Access to the Fair District may only be granted – on a first come, first served basis – to vehicles provided with the special mark, and such vehicles may only be parked in the allocated areas and while the Fair District is open. Failure to adhere to such prescriptions will entitle the Secretariat to have the vehicle taken out of the Fair District and

moved to an attended place, at the risk and expense of the Exhibitor who the mark was given to. The Secretariat shall not be held responsible for the attendance of such vehicle nor for any damage or theft whatsoever.

Art. 20 -SPECIAL BANS — In particular, the Exhibitors may not:

— engage in any sale in which the goods are immediately delivered to the buyer on the place;

— transfer or swap all or part of the booth;

— display prices, except in those areas in which the Secretariat so allows;

— display products that do not belong to the class of commodities for which the booth has been designed or are not stated on the application for participation;

— display signs or samples, even if just for information, on behalf of companies that are not listed in the application for participation and are not represented.

Technical bans issued for safety reasons to protect people and property or to prevent movable and immovable assets of the Fair District from being tampered with, and any attendant prescription contained in the " Technical Exhibition Regulations ", are part of the general terms and conditions hereunder, and the Exhibitors shall strictly adhere to them. Exemptions may be made in writing by the Secretariat. Should the Exhibitor fail to meet any of the above bans or any of the bans herein, the agreement for participation in the Fair may be terminated, without a Judge's ruling, by simply serving written notice thereof to the Exhibitor, at the Exhibitor's booth. This will result in the immediate closing down of the booth and the removal of the documents for access to the Fair District, without prejudice to any payment owed by the Exhibitor.

Art. 21 - POSTPONEMENT, DOWNSIZING OR CANCELLATION OF THE FAIR

At its sole discretion, the Secretariat may change the dates of the Fair, but this will not entitle the Exhibitor to terminate or otherwise withdraw from the agreement or be exempted by the obligations hereunder. In addition, the Secretariat may downsize the Fair or cancel all or part of the Fair, and the Exhibitor will not be entitled to any compensation or damage whatsoever, except the refund of any prepayment made by the Exhibitor.

In these cases, the Secretariat shall serve notice of any such change in writing by registered letter, fax or telegram.

Art. 22 - MISCELLANEOUS - ADDRESS - APPLICABLE LEGISLATION - ITALIAN LAW AND PLACE OF JURISDICTION

— The Exhibitors shall adhere to the prescriptions that the Police Authorities and the authorities in charge of fire prevention, accident prevention and control of public areas may place on the Fair. The Exhibitors and any third party working for them within the Fair District must use employees or self-employed people whose employment contract complies with the applicable laws (in terms of social security, insurance, tax, age).

— The Exhibitors shall take their legal residence in the premises of the Fair and shall submit to the laws of the Republic of Italy and to the jurisdiction of the Court of Ferrara.

— The relationship between the Fair, the Secretariat, the Exhibitor and any third party shall be subject to the laws of the Republic of Italy.

Art. 23 - PRIVACY ACT - Information note for the person concerned, pursuant to article 13 Legislative Decree no 196/2003, and consent form.

Personal details provided by the person concerned are also processed through digital media, for the purposes stated in this application for participation and in the participation forms, so as to pursue the official purposes and any other activity, including related or additional ones, that aims to promote the trade of goods and services of the Organising Secretariat, Ferrara Fiere Congressi S.r.l. and BolognaFiere S.p.A., including any activity for the normal running of the exhibition, online and offline publications, customer satisfaction ratings, commercial or marketing purposes, statistics purposes and the like, which may require disclosure and dissemination of such personal details to third parties in Italy and/or abroad. Therefore, personal details may be processed either directly or through third parties through any media, and such details may be used and disclosed – and even sold to third parties – even outside the national territory for any initiative that may be related to or resulting from the exhibition or aimed to promote the trade of goods and services that are involved in any such initiative – especially to those people who are somehow involved in the work of the Organising Secretariat, Ferrara Fiere Congressi S.r.l. and BolognaFiere – to other persons dealing in fairs or working in the same areas (associations or consortiums – external databanks – market surveys, etc) or persons who are interested in the industries covered by the fair. The Organising Secretariat, Ferrara Fiere Congressi S.r.l. and BolognaFiere S.p.A. are responsible for such processing, in partnership with some subsidiaries of BolognaFiere, as notified by BolognaFiere S.p.A. to the Watchdog authority under the Privacy Act. The persons concerned are entitled to have access to their personal details and complete, correct, update them etc, pursuant to article 7, Legislative Decree no 196/2003; for enquiries, they may contact the Organising Secretariat at www.Fairdelrestauro.com or BolognaFiere at Web www.bolognafiery.it/privacy or Ferrara Fiere Congressi at its registered address. The provision of such personal details and the consent to have them processed are optional, but are essential to perform the aforesaid activities, and the refusal to provide such details, to be stated by the participant on the application for participation, may result in the Organising Secretariat refusing to enter into or fulfil the participation agreement.
